Snyder Students Internship

Purpose:

To help raise and influence the next generation of ministry leaders and allow them to serve in ministry and learn from fellow pastors. 2 Timothy 2:2

Qualifications:

1. A Christian with a clear testimony
2. Demonstrate call to full-time ministry (preferably student ministry)
3. Commitment to future local church ministry
4. Agree to the 10-week summer commitment
5. Currently pursuing an undergraduate degree or higher

Dates:

Between Monday, May 24 – Sunday, August 1 with one week of vacation

Days:

Sunday – Thursday with exception of Student Ministry Events (30 hours a week)

Compensation:

\$3000 for the 10-week commitment

Miles for student ministry tasks will be reimbursed at the end of June and July

Housing:

Housing can be provided for interns who do not live in Fayetteville.

Responsibilities:

1. Attend camp with Snyder Students
2. Help our children's director plan and facilitate VBS
3. Plan and execute 2 student ministry events
4. Teach 2 times during the summer
5. Attend staff stand up each Monday morning and attend staff lunch (Tuesdays at noon) once a month
6. Attend Youth Mission trips, if any are planned for the summer

2. Mentoring:

Meetings once a week with different pastors to discuss ministry
Continued Conversations with Student Pastor and Staff

3. Experience:

Planning and running 2 events/evenings
Planning and teaching twice
Working alongside different ministry leaders to help facilitate events

Application Process

Step 1: Go to snyderstudents.com and click on the “college Intern” tab. Fill out and submit the application. Applications are due by March 31st. You can also email your application to jon@snidermbc.com or drop it off at the office.

Step 2: We will contact you once we have your application.

Step 3: Interns who have moved to the second step in the process will be contacted about a zoom interview and references will be contacted.

Step 4: A second interview may be needed.

Step 5: Fill out employee paperwork and begin the internship.

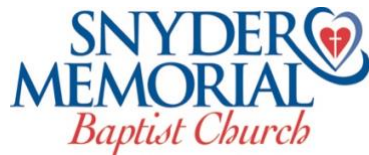
Other Information

Costs:

Interns will be required to pay for their food and transportation. Any miles related to the student ministry will be reimbursed. All student ministry events, camp, trips, meals, and gatherings will be paid for by the student ministry. Interns will be paid bi-weekly in the amount of \$600.

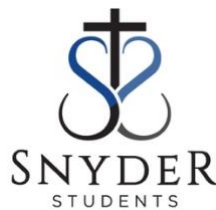
Vacation:

Beliefs

1. **About God** – God is the Creator and Ruler of the universe. He has eternally existed in three persons: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. These three are co-equal and are one God.
2. **About the Father** – He is all-powerful, all-knowing, all-loving, and all-wise. He reigns with providential care over the universe and the flow of human history goes according to His purposes and plan.
3. **About Jesus** – Jesus Christ is the Son of God. He is co-equal with the Father. Jesus has eternally existed and became man at His incarnation.
